

TREK

TREK represents four areas which include Talent, Responsibility, Education and Kindness. You are invited to participate and will be rewarded with purple prides and TREK days if you choose to make the journey. When you complete all of the activities you will be rewarded with a T-shirt and certificate. Students who complete the program a 2nd year will receive TREK shorts. A student who finishes all 3 year years will receive a wall plaque.

To get started, do the following:

1. Choose an activity on the Bingo card that you would like to do and complete it.
2. Fill in the TREK to Success Record and get the adult signature to show that it was done.
3. When you complete a level, meet with a trail boss to stamp your bingo card and give you a purple pride.
4. Watch for TREK days and come to lunch early for a treat.
5. As you complete the program, turn in the TREK to Success Record to Miss Shelley.
6. If finished by April 10th, you will be invited to a leadership team activity.

TREK DAYS

TREK days are held once a month to reward those students who are working on the **TREK** program. A level is completed when a row has been finished and stamped by your trail boss. Students will be released for lunch 5 minutes early and a treat will be available in the lunchroom on **TREK** days. Listen closely to the announcements for **TREK** day information.

CHUCKWAGON CHOICES

A Chuckwagon Choice is part of TREK to promote improvement of yourself, your community, and the school. You will choose what you will do that goes along with Talent, Responsibility, Education and Kindness. For School Chuckwagon Choices some things you can do are to attend sporting events or performances of fellow classmates, enter school competitions such as reflections or the school talent show, or help out a struggling student. For Community Chuckwagon Choices some things you can do are volunteer work, join a community club like 4-H, or participate in community service like "Neighborhood Watch."

TRAIL BOSS

Many teachers volunteer to help stamp your TREK record. Check with your homeroom teacher to see if they will be stamping planners during the channel one time. If they are not a trail boss, you can pass off TREK in the media center, the office, or the guidance center.
